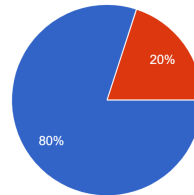

- - Will need to prepare the paperwork with signature and send in request forms to CAS email Goal to get in by Dec 30th
- Planning for 26-27
 - School Budget
 - Projected enrollment SY26-27 189 Ss
 - K-2 (74) students & 3-6 (114) students Pre-K -1 student
 - compared to last year 192 Ss
 - Budget cut of \$112,915
 - (This includes the \$151,792 from PTA to be status quo on current teaching lines)
 - NEEDS:
 - Reduce OA vacant position- \$39,000
 - Reduce .75 EA (Article 6 position) Vacant .5 (working with district to see if they can provide the .25 to make it a .75)
 - Remainder- Not enough to cover current operations- More information on this will be provided in February
 - Continue to request the support of PTA/ Hanalei School Foundation for support for 2 teaching lines at \$151,792
 - As of today PTA doesn't know if they can fund two full teaching lines and maybe can only fund 1.5, at the end of last school year PTA was promised that they would get money back, DOE returned 47,000. PTA should be able to give back. Raise another \$103K to fulfill this shortage.

- Total of all fundraising is at 66.8
