Approve Minutes

- Approve minutes from December meeting - motioned by Rachelle, Seconded by Tony, unanimously approved

Administration Report - Tony Sines

- PLC Hours - in past State has given 21 hours to teachers to use for professional development/recertifications/classifications, State is taking away those hours, but these are vital to the teachers. Tony asking for 30 hours (5 school days) for SY '22-'23 for PLC - school is getting a new math curriculum next year, 3 of those waiver days will dedicated to professional development for that program. Other 2 days worth of hours will be spread out throughout the year to give teachers an opportunity to plan lessons, collaborate with other teachers, etc.
 - Loss of instruction time with children is a con, but the development hours will benefit the students to a larger degree in the long run.
 - School needs to request waiver days from state - first day would be Aug 1st (students return to school Aug 2), 2nd waiver day would be mid-Sept, 3rd waiver day Mid-Jan. Every other Friday (or Thursday) would be early release (12:50), Wednesday early release would remain the same.
 - Looking at options to provide after school enrichment to avoid 2nd early Dismissal - PTA to discuss options.
 - Tony needs SCC to approve 30 hours of lost instructional time/request for waiver days.
 - Rachelle motioned to approve, Kerrin seconded, all approved.
- Hanalei School received the weighted student funding totalling \$137,000. This will afford the school a teacher line, Barton (Carolyn), Sondag (Nuevlyn), and about \$32,000 "left over" - probably a PTT for classroom support.
- ESSR money will fund the RTI position for next year, and Hanalei will not have to ask the PTA for any money next school year to fund teacher salaries.

PTA and HSF Reports:

- PTA Report - (Melanie) - Next Tuesday will be the PTA General Meeting (1/11) @ 5pm. This meeting will discuss Garden maintenance day, recruiting parents for volunteer positions for this year and to encourage parents to join the board next year, also will discuss after school enrichment.
- Hanalei School Foundation (HSF) Report - (Britt) - Britt was able to secure another \$45,000 grant for 3 PTT lines for next year to assist RTI coordinator.
 - Give Big Hawaii raised \$17,600 - possibility of another \$10,000 coming in
 - HSF to work on a spring fundraising campaign. Dates TBA.
