Administration Report - Deena Moraes

- Principal's Report
- 23-24 Academic Financial Plan
 - 3 month process to develop, template went to Leadership Team to ART Team to faculty meeting. All input from these teams went into the document. Meet with KAMBAM, finalize financial plan.
 - ACADEMIC PLAN: SBA ELA and Math steady increase in proficiency over the last few years. Math a little lower % of proficiency but new math curriculum will hopefully help that. Slight decline in Science proficiency, will focus on that in the future, more concerned about math at this point.
 - ID'ing root causes and what enabling activities are we investing in to address causes of problems school is having.
 - No drastic changes, just making adjustments. Good systems already in place at Hanalei S
 - Rec'd funds for ½ academic coach (Paulette Adams, will need to hire a 6th grade teacher). ½ time teacher line for RTI vs PTT, which is what we had this year.
 - 3 RTI teachers plus a coordinator for the RTI program. Julia Donner as coordinator, Nuevelyn Layaoen as Sondag, Carolyn C. as Barton. Maybe 1 -2 more (Chloe F, Julie)
 - Envision paid for 3 years (including this past year)
 - School wide writing program "Write Reflections" K-6. There is a lot of ESSER funds this year, went to district, school makes case to district for funding. iReady has been purchased through 2025 EOY.
 - Hiring for 4th, 6th, SPED teachers.
 - Looking into more Middle School practices, expectations etc.
 - Everyone gets tier 1 instruction. Small group for tier 2 (teacher table - zooming in on missing strategies), also investing in SEL programs. Funding available again for Healthy Keiki program which will enable more PLC time.
 - 3 pieces that go into the budget. Salaried financial plan, operating budget, academic financial plan.
 - Working on refunding the \$45,000 the SCC gave to school via grant to fund RTI PTTs.
 - Finding the personnel to hire is an issue/challenge. Confident that it will get done. In

house open, next move to DOE licensed teachers, then out of state licensed teacher, then Non licensed emergency hires.
